The Programme

Wath Academy Sixth Form's Rugby Union Scholarship, in partnership with the Yorkshire Academy ACE Rugby programme, is a specialist 16–18 initiative designed to provide outstanding opportunities for ambitious and talented Rugby Union players. The programme offers a genuine pathway into semi-professional rugby while ensuring students thrive academically at one of the region's most successful Sixth Forms.

This elite development programme guarantees all scholars access to a high-performance rugby environment alongside their Post-16 education.

Students enrolled on the Rugby Union Scholarship undertake A Levels or equivalent Vocational qualifications, with additional opportunities to gain work-based credentials such as the England Rugby Coaching Award.

Through daily training sessions led by experienced coaches with professional backgrounds, scholars benefit from top-tier rugby development. The programme is designed to advance players' technical abilities, tactical understanding, and overall knowledge of the game—ensuring a comprehensive rugby education that supports long-term success on and off the pitch.

Level 2 RFU Coach Mr Burrows is a Wath Academy alumnus and current professional rugby player at Coventry RFC. He has amassed over 300 professional games and has a wealth of experience and knowledge, having played at Rotherham Titans, Leeds Carnegie and Newcastle Falcons. In total, he has played over 17,000 minutes of professional rugby, scoring 40 tries. Mr Burrows currently works with Coventry U23s, while assisting with Coventry's RFC 1st XV.

Head Coach

Mr Bramhall is a qualified Level 2 RFU Coach with over 10 years' experience of coaching age grade rugby. He is a dual code coach. In 2021, he helped Dearne Valley Bulldogs U13s to win their league undefeated. In 2023, as head coach, he led Rotherham Phoenix Colts to win their league, again undefeated. He is currently Wath Colts' head coach and works with Wath's XI team to help players transition from junior to men's rugby.

Mr Lines has worked at Wath Academy for 13 years and has coached school teams extensively throughout that time, as well as assisting in junior representative rugby. He has played for Wath RUFC for numerous years, playing more games and captaining the club more than anyone in their history.
