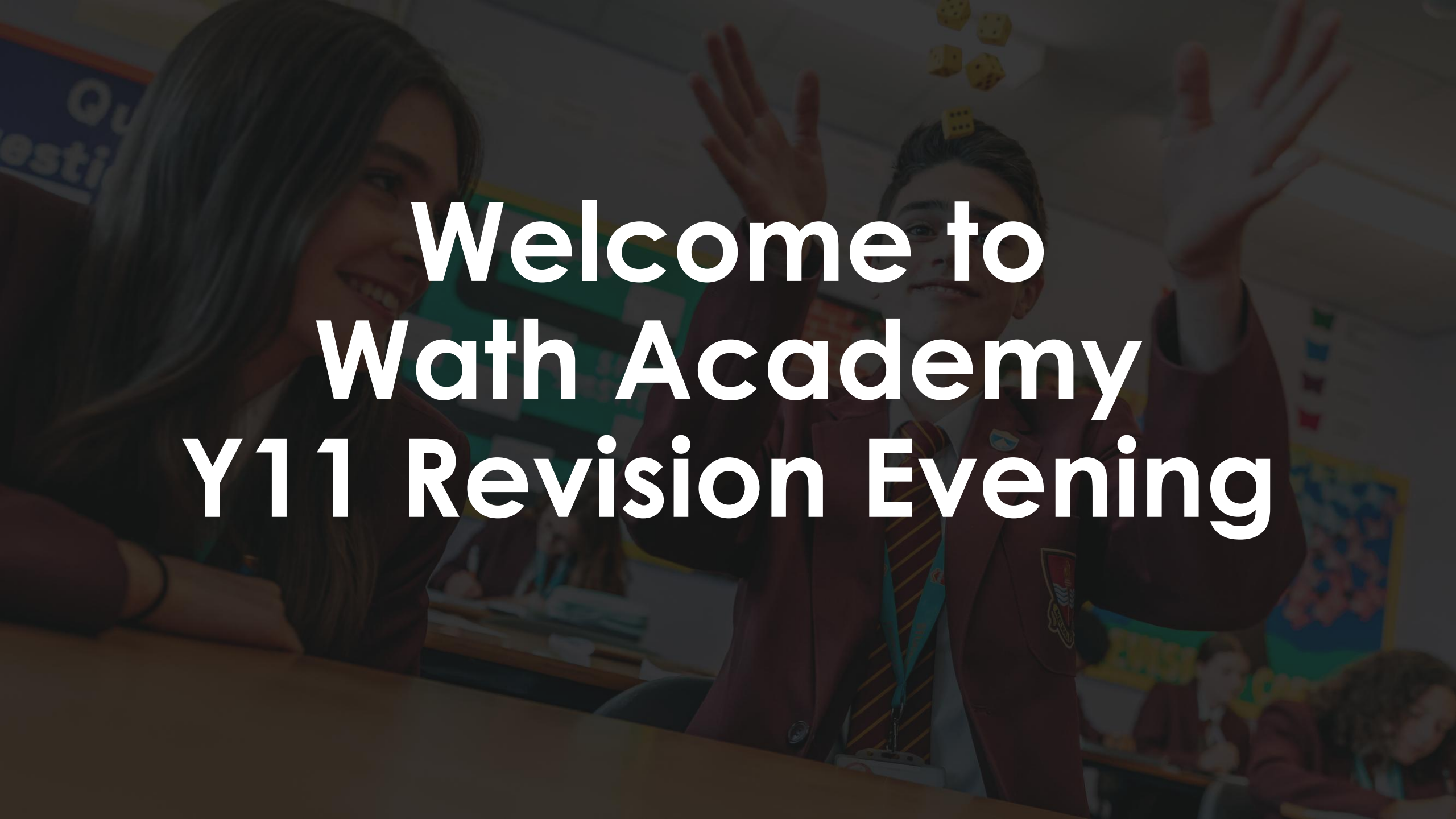
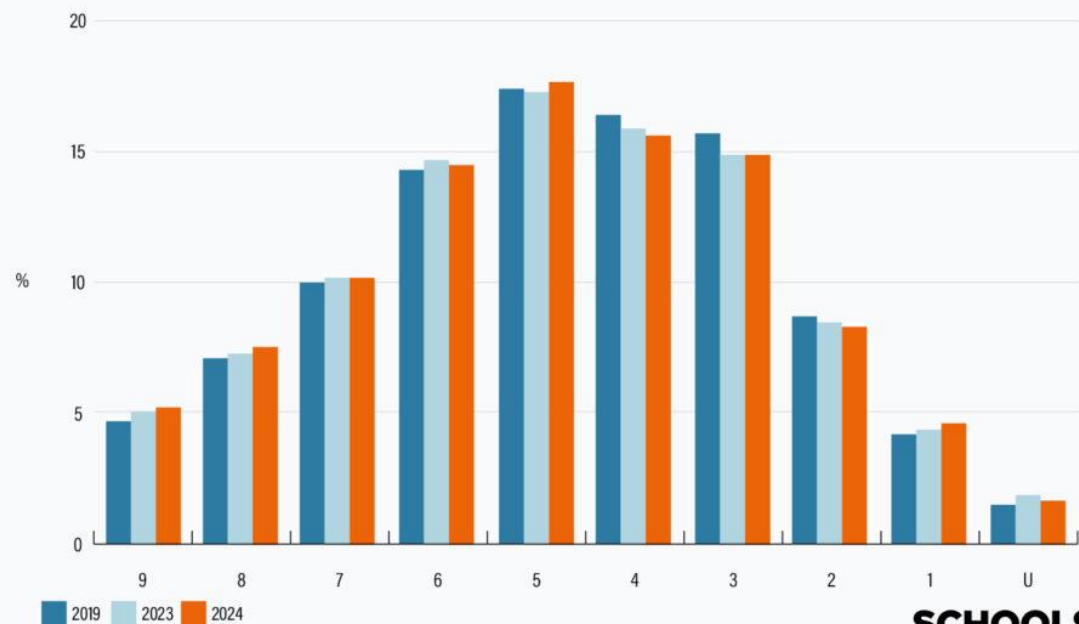

Each year the numbers of grades given are roughly the same

The number of grade 9s is roughly 4% each year

This is regardless of difficulty of paper

Ultimately, students are ordered in a big national league table by raw score in each subject

Then they exam board work their way down the list, Top 4% get a grade 9, next 7% (roughly) grade 8 etc

Students are in direct competition with others. It is not the case that they need to get a certain amount of marks to get a grade 4 for example

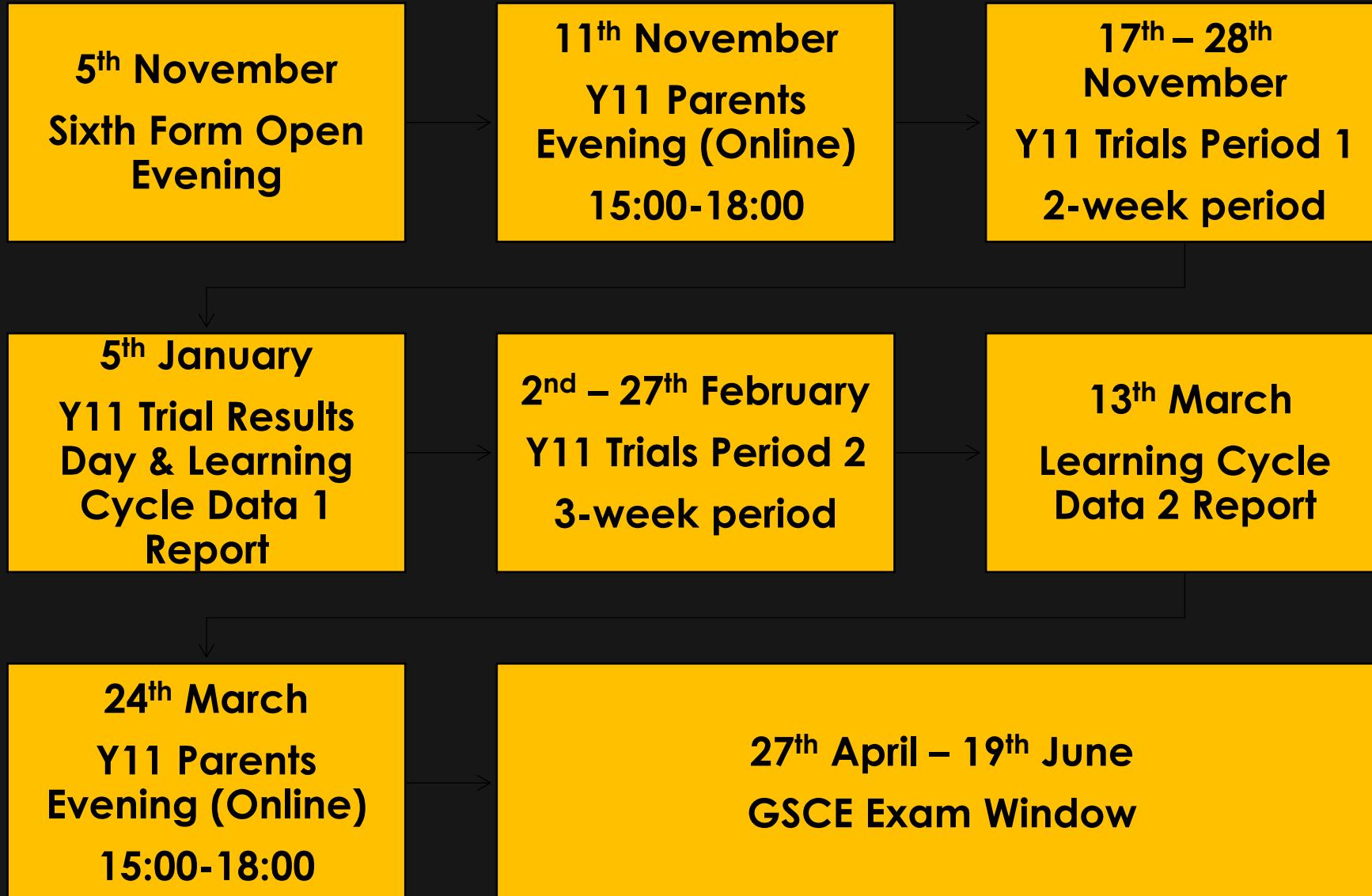

Method marks make up 75% of every Maths exam.

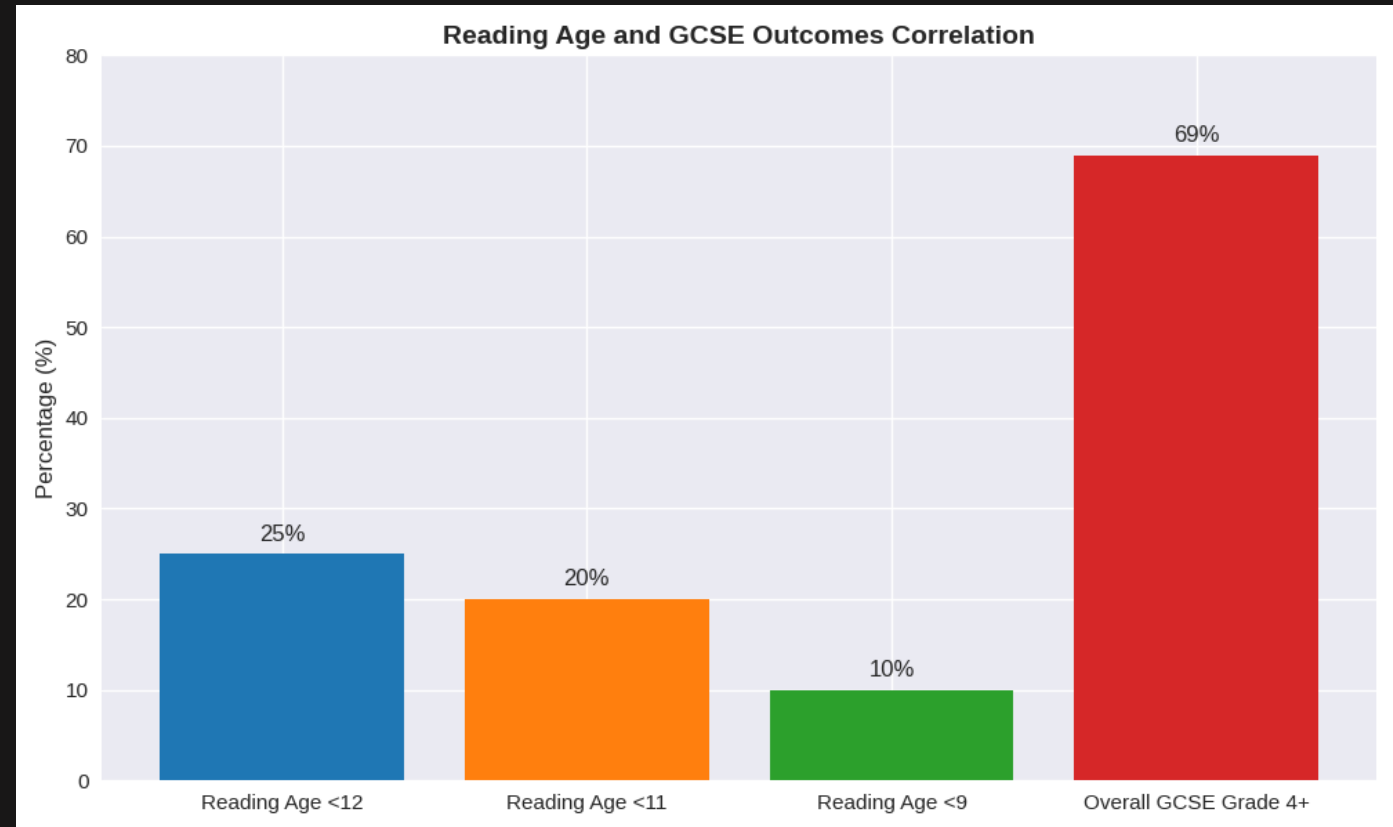
Practice of written method is vital in maths.
